McCook Central/Montrose hands Groton Area first state tourney loss

Groton Area's state volleyball premier was set back by McCook Central/Montrose as the Fighting Cougars posted a 3-1 win over the Lady Tigers.

The State A Volleyball Tournament is being played at the Rushmore Plaza Civic Center in Rapid City.

McCook Central/Montrose jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first set. The Tigers closed to within one several times but was unable to tie the game. McM upped its lead to eight at 20-12 before going on to a 25-17 first set win.

Coach Chelsea Hanson said, "I think we had some first set jitters but even then we told the girls that we aren't playing our best and we're still in the game so go out and compete and they did."

Groton Area scored the first point in the second set before the Fighting Cougars took a 5-2 lead. Groton Area scored four straight points as Nicole Marzahn hit the game tying kill at five. Marzahn would later tie the game at 7 with a termination, but McM would not give up its lead. The Fighting Cougars then scored four straight to take an 11-7 lead. Groton Area would rally for seven straight points with Kenzie McInerney having two kills and Marzahn and Eliza Wanner adding a kill each during the rally. The Tigers took a 14-11 lead and from there, the Tigers were not going to be denied the win and posted a 25-19 second set win. Marzahn had four kills, an ace serve and a block in the second set. Indigo Rogers and Kenzie McInerney each had two kills, Stella Meier and Eliza Wanner each had a kill and Payton Colestock had an ace serve.

"We regained our composure in the second set and I thought we played really well. We struggled at first, but our seniors stepped up and took control of the set. I was really pleased with our determination. It was also fun hearing the cheering of our fans. We have such a good following all the way here in Rapid City."

Groton Area jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the third set, but McM would score nine straight points to take a 9-3 lead. Groton Area closed to within ine at 12-12 with an ace serve by Kaylin Kucker, but then McM would score six straight to take a 19-12 lead and would go on to win, 25-16. Marzahn had five kills in that set, Wanner would have a pair of kills while Madeline Fliehs and Kaylin Kucker would each have a kill and Colestock had an ace serve.

"Hanson said, MCM was a great team and did a good job keeping us out of system so we couldn't run our offense like we were used to and that was one thing we haven't had to do much this season, but every game here we will have to get better and try our best to control the ball well."

McCook Central/Montrose jumped out to a 5-0 lead in the third set. The Tigers would close to within two at 6-4 and it was still just a three-point margin at 10-7. Then the Fighting Cougars would score five straight points to take a 17-9 lead. Groton Area would close to within three late in the set at 20-17, 21-18, 22-19, 23-20 and 24-21 but McM would finish off the set with a 25-21 win. In the fourth set, Marzahn had five kills, Payton Colestock had four ace serves, Rogers and Wanner each had two kills and Fliehs had one.

For the match, Nicole Marzahn had 15 kills, nine digs, two ace serves ad one block. Eliza Wanner had 15 digs and nine kills. Indigo Rogers had six kills, two digs, one assist and one block. Madeline Fliehs had three kills and two digs. Tadyn Glover had 16 digs and three assists. Payton Colestock had six ace serves, four digs and three assists. Kenzie McInerney had two kills and a block. Stella Meier had two kills ad one dig. Kaylin Kucker had 28 assists and one kill.

Aleah Ries led McCook Central/Montrose with 16 kills while Maleah Gordon and Abigail Van Ruler each had 13 kills.

"We've had a lot of fun here this week so far," Hanson said. "We didn't win but we competed well and had our opportunities to win and that's all we can ask for day in and day out!"

Groton Area played Madison next. "Madison is a good team with strong hitters and big blockers, they will earn points and we will earn ours," Hanson said. "If we compete like we did tonight we will be in every game. The girls are really enjoying being in this environment together and it's fun to be a part of!"







Madison takes down Groton Area in three sets

Groton Area suffered a 3-0 loss to Madison in the consolation round of the State A Volleyball Tournament being played in Rapid City.

"The first set was tied eight times with the last tie at 11. Madison then went on a four point spurt and followed up with three straight points to take a 17-12 lead. The Bulldogs added five straight points to take a 23-15 lead and went on to win, 25-17.

The second set was tied five times in the early part and the Tigers took a 9-6 lead. Madison came back to score six straight points to take a 14-10 lead and then upped it to 18-11 en route to a 25-15 win.

Madison scored the first three points of the third set and three was the closest Groton Area could get to the Bulldogs. Madison had several three-point rallies and went on to win, 25-14.

Madison took control of the terminations with a 37-24 advantage. Madison had 35 assists compared to 18 for Groton Area. The Tigers had one ace serve, that by Tadyn Glover, while Madison had two ace serves. The Bulldogs had 10 blocks and had the edge in digs, 80-77.



Huskies win last two sets to sneak past **Groton Area**

Groton Area's volleyball team took the court in fighting style in the seventh place match at the State A Tournament in Rapid City Saturday morning. The Tigers jumped out to a 2-0 lead and upped it 6-1. Elk Point-Jefferson fought back to within two, 9-7, before the Tigers rattled off four straight points to take a 13-7 lead. The Huskies clawed their way back and tied the first set at 24. Groton Area would score the last two points to win, 26-24. Kaylin Kucker and Payton Colestock each had an ace serve. Indigo Rogers and Nicole Marzahn each had a block. Eliza Wanner had three kills, Rogers had two and Stella Meier and Marzahn each had one kill.

Groton Area jumped out to a 5-1 lead in the second set and held a five-point lead at 13-8. Elk Point-Jefferson came back tied the set at 16. From there, it was back and forth and the game tied eight times including as late as a tie at 24 and the lead changed hands three times before the Huskies scored the last two points to win the game, 26-24. Wanner had seven kills, Madeline Fliehs and Marzahn each had two kills and Kenzie McInerney had one. Marzahn had an ace serve.


Now with the match tied at one, the Tigers came out roaring in the third set, taking a 4-0 lead and ended up with a double digit lead at 18-8 and went on to win, 25-14. Madeline Fliehs had the final three kills of the game to help post the win.

Elk Point-Jefferson started out the fourth set with a 6-0 lead, forcing the Tigers to battle back. Groton Area tied the set at 12 and 13 and took a 16-13 lead. Groton Area upped its lead to four at 18-14, but the Huskies came back to tie the game at 19. Groton Area tied the game at 20 and 21 and took a 22-21 lead. Elk Point-Jefferson tied the game at 22 and scored the next three points to win the game, 25-22.

That set up the fifth set as the Huskies jumped out to a 5-0 lead but the Tigers once again, fighting to come back. Fliehs had a kill to the game at 11, but the Tigers were unable to capture the lead and Elk Point-Jefferson went on to win, 15-13.

Elk Point-Jefferson had the edge in kills, 60-58. The Tigers had the edge in ace serves, 7-6. Blocks took its toll on the Tigers with Elk Point-Jefferson having 10 compared to four for Groton Area. The defense was even on the digs with Groton Area having the edge, 114-112. Eliza Wanner had 20 kills, 15 digs and one assist. Nicole Marzahn had 15 kills, 17 digs, one block and one ace serve. Indigo Rogers had 11 kills, two ace serves and one block. Kaylin Kucker had 46 assists, two ace serves and five kills.. Tadyn Glover had 33 digs and five assists. Kenzie McInerney had two kills, Stella Meier had one kill and one block, Payton Colestock had two ace serves and 13 digs. Madeline Fliehs had four kills, one assist, eight digs and two blocks.







When you're in the state tournament, it's not really about playing volleyball at the top level. It's about trying to keep your opponents from playing at their top level. It's really more of a game of errors rather than a game of kills. We knew coming in that we would have kills that no body can touch and that they would have kills on us that we couldn't touch.

The McCook Central-Montrose match took a lot out of the girls on Thursday. They were exhausted at the end of the match. It was not our best night offensively, but we were right there defensively. We did a lot of good things.

We were off against Madison, but we still competed. I was really proud of the girls and they're having a lot of fun. Any time we get digs, it's big. We are completely undersized here at the state tournament. We are so small and everyone is just hitting right over us.

The Madison match was uncharacteristic of our team. I told the girls to not revert back to the things that did not make us successful. We've done good things and we belong in the state tournament. We are good and we're playing good teams that are taking us out of our system. Most of the volleyball matches we've played we've been in system 80 percent of the time. Now we're in system 20 percent of the time. It's not that we're playing bad. It's because the competition is good. We don't play high level competition all year. It would be nice to be able to play teams like McCook Central or Madison every night. I would love to see how our team would improve with that level of competition. There's a lot of teams on our schedule that are not as strong as I would like them to be for us to get better. We're scouted well here. We're playing teams that have evaluated our whole season and they've had a week to prepare for us. It's no secrete that we go to Nicole and we go to Eliza and we go to Indigo and that's no secrete on our offense. When you play most teams, you can get away with having three people getting the kills. Here, you can't. You have to be able to have four or five people contributing.

I'm looking forward to the match against Elk Point-Jefferson. Our girls are ready for a top notch match.


